

SEPTEMBER 24 – VIDEO VIA ZOOM: This is a change from the in-person meeting announcement in our last newsletter to a video via Zoom. Catherine Delfs could not find an in-person demonstrator for September after numerous attempts, and the officers concluded "It might as well be a video shown via Zoom." The video will be "Bold & Beautiful – Backyard Wildlife in Watercolor" by Susan Bourdet, a popular Audubon print artist, author and teacher. She has a background in biology and loves photographing wildlife in her home state of Oregon. Susan demonstrates tips on photographing wildlife, how to create luminous wet-into-wet backgrounds, dry brush weathered wood, knot holes and nails, and use of gouache to add sunlit sparkle. Also demonstrated is how to achieve depth while maintaining the illusion of soft feathering, plus a cascade of delicate vibrant flowers. This 75 minute video also includes short cuts, product tips and safeguards. Google
