MAY ART SHOW CANCELED: We put out a request in our February Bark for volunteer(s) to head up or help with the Student Division of our in-person art show this May, and not one member responded, so a phone vote was taken of our Officers and Board of Directors and it was decided that the nearly \$3,000 total cost of putting on our annual show was not justifiable with only 120* adult paintings (*usual number of adult entries).
