JUNE 24 at 7:00pm (Zoom) – JIM CALDWELL (art history slides) Jim will present an art history slide presentation entitled “Leonardo and his Ladies, plus the Last Supper.” He will speak about Leonardo’s genius and do a deep dive into seven of his famous portraits including the Mona Lisa, and the Last Supper, while showing 50 breathtaking images. After winning a high school art prize in 1960, Jim went on to major in art at Williams College, and then spent the year following his graduation at the Ecole des Beaux Arts in Paris, traveled extensively creating watercolors, drawings, and paintings and then returned to the United States for graduate school at Yale where he received his Master of Architecture Degree in 1969. He divides his time between painting and residential architectural design at his studio in Woodside, and teaches painting and drawing at Filoli in Woodside, CA.
