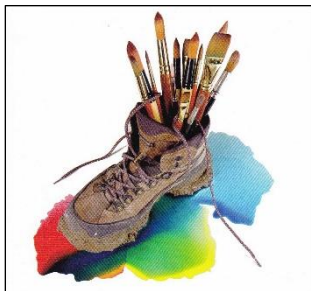

ART BIAS OPEN HOUSE: The first Sunday of every month Art Bias at 1700 Industrial Road in San Carlos has an Open House from 12:00-4:00pm. The next open house is November 6th, and their building now has studios on both floors which takes a while to tour.

PACIFIC ART LEAGUE: The current exhibit is “Emerging Artists – Abstract Art” and runs October 7-25. You can view shows even if a class is going on. Their address is 668 Ramona Street, Palo Alto. Park for free below the Palo Alto City Hall across the street.

KAAREN MARQUEZ EXHIBIT: Visit the Viewpoints Gallery at 315 State Street, Los Altos, CA, 11:00am-5:00pm, Wednesday-Sunday. The latest oil paintings are Italy “Beyond the Piazza” through October.

SAN FRANCISCO MUSEUM OF MODERN ART: Diego Rivera’s “America” exhibit is on the fourth floor through January 2, 2023, which consists of 150 works from the 1920s to mid-1940s. Also Alexander Calder’s “Dissonant Harmony” is on the third floor through May 2023, and Carlos Meridas’ “Mythic Constructions” and Paul Klee are on the second floor through December 2022.

DeYOUNG MUSEUM EXHIBITS: Faith Eingold’s “American People” is on display through November 27, 2022, Hung Liu’s “Golden Gate” until January 8, 2023, and Julia Brenner’s “Textile Collection” through July 9, 2023. Attendance is free every Saturday to residents of all nine Bay Area counties.

LEGION OF HONOR MUSEUM EXHIBITS: Michelle Ericson’s “Wild Porcelain” is on display through November 20, 2022, as well as Guo Pei’s “Couture Fantasy.”

PORTOLA ART GALLERY: Located at Allied Arts, 75 Arbor Road, Menlo Park, is open Monday-Saturday 11:00am-4:00pm. The current exhibit is entitled “Beauty of Wood Fired Ceramics” featuring ceramics by Misako Kambe. This exhibit will run until October 31, 2022.
