Then we will have Inna present her demonstration, and afterward if members still want to check garage sale items, they may continue to do so. You must take any unclaimed items home with you at end of this evening. Bring your painting/photograph for Popular Vote to this meeting.

Inna Zatulovsky was born in Kiev, Ukraine, and was educated as a mechnical engineer. She worked at the Semiconductor Manufacturing Company in Silicon Valley for 23 years before retiring. She is best known for her floristic collages, but loves to explore different art forms. She heard about dry felt painting from one of these artists in the San Jose area, but took a master class in the country of Georgia from a famous artist. Georgian shepherds were using felt as bedding, tent coverings and coats to keep themselves warm, then someone decided to "get creative" with this material. Inna has a studio at Art Bias, 1700 Industrial Road, San Carlos.
