AUGUST 25 (Friday) CHERYL PERMAN-RUSKIN (papier mache) 7:00pm, Gold Star <u>Room at Veterans Memorial Senior Center</u>: One of our newer members volunteered to give us a demonstration on how she does papier mache/paper clay sculptures. We always like to learn about other art medias. You never know, you may wish to "give it a try." Cheryl has been painting, drawing, or printing monotypes for the last 45 years, and is primarily an abstract artist. She most recently studied Chinese brush contemporary "splash" painting for three years with Susan Chan. At the beginnng of 2022 she read a New York Times article about the resurgence of papier mache as an art form. The simple recipe of flour, water and shredded newspaper allowed artists to continue making things when other supplies were hard to get during the Covid shutdown. This sparked her interest and she set about making small tabletop sculptures. Looking for ways to make her sculptures more durable, she discovered paper clay which had the additives of glue, cement or joint compound added to the paper. The "bug has

bitten" and she gets immense pleasure in creating papier mache/paper sculpture sculptures and usually has three or four in the works at the same time. Hope to see you in August at 7:00pm!
