It has been several years since we had one of Jim's wonderful art history slide presentations. This is his latest on the final decades of Sargent's life when at 51 he announced that he was closing his famous portrait studio and would spend the rest of lis life painting watercolors for his own pleasure. Sargent went to Madrid when he was 23 to study Velasquez first hand. He soon fell in love with everything Spanish, returning six more times, and visiting 26 Spanish cities. He loved Flamenco, the Roma (gypsy) people, the Moorish castle of the Alhambra, and the spirituality of the

Spaniards. You won't want to miss Jim's meticulous research and information on this unknown aspect of Sargent's artistic life, with 60 selected images from these years
